

CANADIANS ARE CONCERNED ABOUT CANNABIS-IMPAIRED DRIVING

With the legalization of cannabis soon to be a reality, the majority of Canadians are concerned about cannabis-impaired drivers on the road.



78%
of Canadians are concerned about cannabis-impaired drivers on the road once cannabis becomes legal.



62%
of Canadian cannabis users have either driven or been a passenger in a car where the driver had recently consumed cannabis.



84%
of Canadians believe that driving while high poses a real risk.



43%
of Canadians stated that they do not know how long to wait before it is safe to drive once they have consumed cannabis.



70%
of Canadians believe that driving while high is as dangerous as driving while impaired by alcohol.



61%
of Canadian cannabis users believe it's safe to wait less than three hours after consuming cannabis to drive.
