

Tips:

keep your Vehicle Safe

1. Never leave keys in the ignition or in your car not even a hidden spare.
2. Use your garage.
3. Close windows and sunroof.
4. Lock doors and activate security alarms.
5. Take valuables with you when you leave your car: cash, credit cards, cellular phones, GPS devices, etc.
6. If you have no choice, make sure valuables are locked in the trunk.
7. Make sure your keys are secure at home and at work. Do not place your keys on a key holder near the front door of your house.
8. Always report suspicious activities to your local police.

Auto theft:

Why vehicles are stolen?

■ For transportation:

Thieves will use your vehicle to get where they want to go and later abandon the vehicle. They may just drive it around to gain “status” with their Friends. Often these vehicles are burnt.

■ To commit other crimes:

Vehicles are stolen and used in other crimes such as robberies, break and enters and drug dealing.

■ To sell for vehicle parts:

Thieves may take your car out of the province or country. Identification numbers may be altered or removed, ownership certificates forged, parts sold or the vehicle repainted.
