IBC Announces February 1, 2012, Go-live Date for 2012 CLSP

Insurance Bureau of Canada (IBC) is pleased to confirm that the data collection and correction systems supporting the 2012 Commercial Liability Statistical Plan (CLSP) will go live on Wednesday, February 1, 2012.

In order to complete the cutover from the current system to the new system, the collection and processing of CLSP and Automobile Statistical Plan (ASP) data will be shut down beginning Friday, January 27, at 5 p.m.

- CLSP files transmitted to the current system as of Friday, January 27, at 5 p.m. will be rejected.
- ASP files received by IBC during the shutdown period will be processed on Monday, January 30, 2012.
- CLSP files in the new 600-byte format will be processed beginning on Wednesday, February 1, 2012.
- OSAB file collection and processing will not be affected during the shutdown.

SMART, Prime, Expert and OSAB EEC web-based applications will not be affected during the shutdown. However, Submission Management and Auto EEC will not be available during this cutover period.
