## **Early Warning System (EWS) Commercial Liability Statistical Plan (CLSP) – User Access and Training**

Insurance Bureau of Canada (IBC) is pleased to advise that the existing commercial liability data accuracy profiles are being re-engineered to speed up the analysis of reported data and will be included in the Early Warning System application, similar to the automobile data accuracy profiles.

The base for the new EWS CLSP anomaly rules will be the current commercial liability profiles.

IBC will begin using the EWS profiles in early June 2012. This system will help IBC analyze company-reported data and identify anomalies early, to allow for corrections of reported data prior to its use in industry exhibits.

A list of the new CLSP anomaly rules description is attached to this bulletin.

The Automobile Statistical Plan (ASP) anomaly rules have also been modified for easier identification. The plan code has now been included in the definition. For example, BCP406001 has been changed to BCP8406001. The new list of ASP anomaly rules is attached.

IBC will be holding training sessions for the industry during May 2012 to ensure that companies have all the tools and knowledge needed to effectively use the new system.
