RE: **Automobile Statistical Plan Changes – Effective January 1, 2014**

The General Insurance Statistical Agency (GISA) is pleased to announce the implementation of changes to the Automobile Statistical Plan (ASP), resulting from an initiative to harmonize and rationalize the ASP data collected. The changes, implemented November 1, 2013, are effective for all premium and loss transactions reported with a Policy Effective date of January 1, 2014 and later.

In 2011, the Superintendents of Insurance from the member jurisdictions of GISA made the decision to unbundle some ASP data elements and collect sufficient detail for other ASP data elements, in order to make it more relevant in carrying out regulatory responsibilities. Since then, industry representatives have participated in working groups and system testing to facilitate the implementation of the changes.

GISA would like to thank you for your cooperation and encourages your organization to work collaboratively with GISA's statistical service provider (Insurance Bureau of Canada) in order to ensure that the data submitted is timely and accurate.
