RE: **Update on the Revised Deficiency Fee System**

The General Insurance Statistical Agency is pleased to advise that the Revised Deficiency Fee System was successfully implemented on February 1st.

Accordingly, January 2014 invoices will be based on the Revised Deficiency Fees System and will be distributed to the industry shortly. In accordance with prevailing practice, reporting companies will continue to receive a paper copy of the summary invoices in the mail. However, details regarding the fees will now only be available online via the new Deficiency Fee online application accessible through the GISA Portal.

As noted in the GISA Bulletin 2013-10 issued November 2013, access to the online application will be automatically granted to all users currently classified as a Statistical Submission Coordinator (SSC) as well as those who completed the online Access Request Form distributed to the industry at that time. Notification of access to the Deficiency Fee Online Application Tool will be issued to all users via email notification.
