RE: **Early Warning System– 2014 Changes**

With the successful implementation of the 2014 Automobile Statistical Plan (ASP) Changes, new fields and values are now required to be reported on all policies with effective dates of January 1, 2014 and later. As a result, the Early Warning System (Data Accuracy System) has also been updated to accommodate these new reporting requirements.

New Anomaly Rules have been developed as well as modifications to existing Anomaly Rules have been made to accommodate the 2014 ASP Changes. Implementation of the new and updated rules is scheduled in April 2014.

Anomaly Rules that are normally run on a monthly basis, (i.e. Benchmark Anomaly Rules), will run on a Quarterly basis initially to analyze the data reported with entry dates for the first quarter of 2014 (January – March 2014). Once this initial run has been completed, the normal monthly schedule will resume.

Please find attached the updated ASP Anomaly Business Rule Descriptions documentation. All new and updated Anomaly Rules have been identified in both the Revision History as well as flagged by date throughout the manual.
