

Error Threshold Changes

In addition to the Tips bulletin send out on March 21, 2011 regarding the **IBC Monthly Automobile Close-Off Procedures**, IBC is making additional changes in an effort to reduce the number of errors generated with your submissions.

IBC is tightening the error threshold on reported submissions. For those of you unfamiliar with the term, **error threshold** refers to the volume of errors in each batch. If the volume of errors in a batch is greater than the first error threshold, it is put on HOLD and can only be moved into a different status by a DQA. If the volume of errors is greater than the second error threshold, the batch is automatically deleted. The results of each batch submitted to IBC are listed on the Statistical Submission Status Report available Submission Management module of the ASP Portal.

We urge you to review your internal systems and to make all the necessary changes and fixes to reduce the number of errors submitted.

The new threshold will be in production as of October 1st 2011.
